

Fourth Grade Memory

Memory work will be due every Friday. If we do not have school on Friday, it will be due that Thursday. The students will show their memory of the verse by reciting the verse.

Students will be given the opportunity to earn 5 extra credit points on quiz days. These points will be awarded to students who are able to locate the memory chapter and verse without using the table of contents or page number.

Students will also be given a weekly grade for practicing their memory. This practice will be due before the student recites his or her memory. Students will be given two options to showcase their practice and the rubrics for the scoring of these two options can be found at the end of this memory schedule.

Homework Options:

1. Write memory 3 times on a piece of notebook paper, including the citation.
2. Create a memory verse poster that includes:
 - The whole verse
 - The verse citation (ex: "Joshua 1:9)
 - A picture relevant to the message of the verse.
 - In color (no white space)
